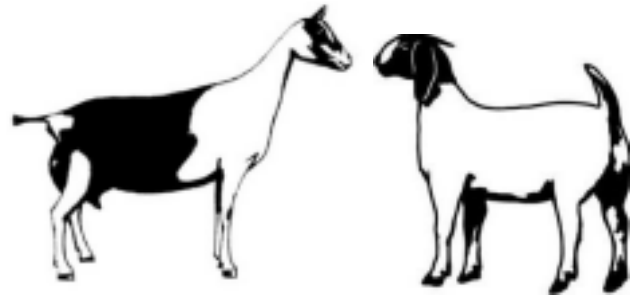

GOAT SHOW RULES

An Invitational 4-H Youth Goat Show for youth in grades 1 through 13 will be held at the Gloucester County 4-H Fair on Friday July 29, 2022 starting at 1pm in the Livestock barn.

SHOW RULES

1. The show is open to 4-H Members in the State of New Jersey, and is not a sanctioned show. Members must be in Good Standing. Cloverbuds, grades 1 to 3, may exhibit but will not be judged and all will receive a participation ribbon. 2. This show is for the following: American/Purebreds, Recorded Grades, Meat/Dairy, Unrecorded Grades, Wethers and Fiber Breeds.
3. Required for unrecorded goats: (1) The goat need not be tattooed; (2) If the animal is not owned by the exhibitor a note must be enclosed with your entry form written by a 4-H club leader (not related to you) or your County Agent, stating when the animal was purchased.
4. Meat & Fiber Breeds are the only horned animals allowed.
5. All exhibitors must show in a showmanship class.
6. To be eligible to be shown at the Gloucester County 4-H Goat Show, the animal must have been a project animal since May 1 of the current year of the show (with the exception of kids born to a qualified project doe after May 1).
- 7. Entry forms are due by July 20, 2022.**
8. The base date for computing an animal's age is July 30th 2022.
9. All animals being shown must be registered with the appropriate 4-H county office by May 1 of the current year, with the exception of kids born to a registered project doe born after May 1st.
10. **All out of county entries MUST provide copies of current 4-H Livestock Registration form (s), Loan-A-Goat form (s) and health papers. A certified veterinary inspection dated within 90 days of the show must also be shown. Diseased animals must be removed.**
11. A doe that has ever freshened or is in milk (being milked regularly) shall compete in the Senior Division. Any doe 24 months or under, that has never freshened, shall compete in the Junior Division. Any doe over 24 months of age that has never freshened can be shown in the Senior Division, but will lose mammary system points.
12. **Animals arriving the day of the show shall be checked in by 12:00PM.** Exhibitors must provide their own feed, hay, water containers and utensils, and a way to contain their goats in one area.
13. Dam and daughters do not have to be owned by one person. They must be entered separately and ownership indicated.
14. County Herd will consist of 2 in milk, 2 dry does, and 1 optional doe. This class need not be entered on entry form but must be a prior registered animal and must be shown in their appropriate class. Herd may be made up on the day of the show.
15. There will be no pre-show milk-out. Over distention of the udders will be discriminated against by the judge.
16. A white uniform is required for showing dairy goats- white pants, white collared shirt, black or brown belt & shoes. Meat goat class requires a white shirt, black pants and black or brown belt and shoes.
17. All exhibitors are responsible for their animals at all times during the hours of the show and while on the property. Please follow the suggestions of the Show Chairperson who will determine the best ways to keep the program flowing smoothly.
18. The Danish system of judging will be used. Ribbons awarded are: Blue - Excellent, Red -

Very Good,
and Yellow - Good.

Additional prizes for Showmanship will be awarded.
