Rules

All Salem County 4-H Livestock Rules also apply to this show.

- This show is open to both Cloverbud and regular 4-H members in good standing in a 4-H goat club.
- Cloverbud member grade K-3 (as of September 2022). The Cloverbud exhibition is a non-competitive showmanship class. The Cloverbud may only show one goat and it is in showmanship only. There will be a 4-H member to escort the Cloverbud member into the ring.
- All animals that are shown must be a 4-H project this year and recorded in a project book. This is not a sanctioned show.
- All goats must be owned by the member or loaner goat agreement completed by May 1, 2023.
- Entry fee: \$3.00 per animal. There is not a fee for showmanship. All entries are due July 10, 2023.
- Salem County 4-H Goat Herders, Salem County Fair Association, or the Salem County 4-H can not be held responsible for loss, damage, accident or illness to any person, animal or property at the fairgrounds. All animals entered at the owner's risk.
- Goats must be free from foot rot, sore mouth, ringworm, abscess, open sores, general poor health or any other infectious or potential contagious diseases. If any of these symptoms are present the owner will be told to take the animal off of the fairgrounds.
- Health papers must be present and completed by a veterinarian which covers August 8, 2023. Goats must have a USDA flock Identification Tag or Tattoo, or national goat association tattoo. Those identifications should match the health papers signed by veterinarian.
- Goats must be checked in by 6:00 PM. Judging will start with showmanship at 6:30 PM.
- There are no pens provided for day of show. If you choose to bring a pen you may set it up outside of the livestock arena. Bring your own buckets, hay and leads. Water is available on property.
- Members are required to do their own fitting and handling at the show and on fairgrounds. Clean up of your area during and when you are finished with the area.
- White shirt long or short sleeve, white pants or jeans are require to show all dairy goat breeds. Members showing meat goat breeds or companion goats may wear black pants or jeans, with white shirt long or short sleeve. No open toes or open back shoes. Prefer boots.
- This show is for: Alpine, Nubian, Saanen, LaMancha, Recorded Grade, Toggenburg, Oberhalsi, Nigerian Dwarf, Unrecorded Grades, Pygmy, Boer, Mytonic, Meat goats, Fiber goats, Dairy goats, Market goats.

- Companion goats (does and wether) Silky Fainting Goats, Pygmy (if not listed and being used as dairy or meat goat), dairy wethers and dairy does >24 months never freshened, meat goat wethers over 12 months of age and does over 24 months never freshened.
 - Meat Goats: Does under 24 months of age that have not freshened. Doe over 24 month and has freshened. Wethers under 12 months of age, not entered in Market Goat.
 - You do not need to write the class on the entry form. Do include what category on entry form, Dairy mark in milk or dry, Companion Goat, Meat goat, Market goat, Fiber goat.

- All members, adults, and volunteers representing the 4-H family should be dressed in clean appropriate attire.
 - Adults are not to enter the ring unless requested by judge, or 4-H leader/ volunteer assisting with show.
 - 4-H members dressed for showing may enter the ring to assist with an animal if needed.
 - Good sportsmanship is a must by both members, friends and family. We are paying for a judges opinion. There are times the judge's opinion is different than ours. Please respect the opinion of the judge and use it as a learning and growth experience.
